

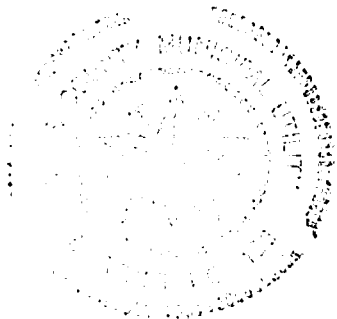


NOTICE

In accordance with Chapter 551, Texas Government Code and Section 49.063, Texas Water Code, both as amended, take notice that the Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 136 will meet in regular session, open to the public, at the Deerfield Village Community Association, 4045 Deerfield Village Drive, Houston, Harris County, Texas, 77084, at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 12, 2018. At such meeting, the Board will consider the following:

1. Approve minutes of the meeting of March 8, 2018.
2. Public comments.
3. Review Bookkeeper's Report, investment report, and authorize payment of bills.
4. Review Tax Assessor and Collectors Report, and authorize payment of bills.
5. Delinquent Tax Attorney Report and take any necessary action regarding Delinquent Accounts including Termination of Service.
6. Consider Windsong Trail road reconstruction project by Harris County Precinct 3 and take appropriate action.
7. Review Engineer's Report, Jackrabbit Road Public Utility District matters, Asset Management Plan, and take appropriate action on engineer's recommendations.
8. Review Operations Report, authorize repairs, and authorize termination of services to delinquent accounts.
9. Discuss Jackrabbit Road Wastewater Treatment Plant, Communication Plan, Lift Station operation, and board meeting attendance, and take appropriate action.
10. Discuss Water Plant fence condition and develop plan for systematically repairing and/or replacing portions of the fence.
11. Discuss Greenhouse Road Landfill Expansion and take appropriate action.
12. Approve SB625 filing.
13. Discuss District website and take appropriate action.
14. Discuss trash and recycling collection operations and take appropriate action.
15. Report on WHCRWA monthly meeting.
16. Review Article for DVCA Newsletter.
17. Review agenda items for next meeting (May 10, 2018) and such other matters as may properly come before the Board.
