

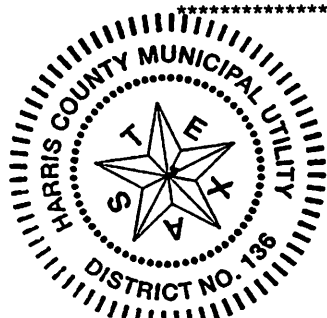
HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 136

At such meeting, the Board will consider the following:

4. Adopt budget for fiscal year ending March 31, 2021.
5. Consider Electricity Purchase Contract extension.
6. Review Tax Assessor and Collectors Report, and authorize payment of bills.
7. Review Engineer's Report, Jackrabbit Road Public Utility District matters, Pine Forest Country Club matters, Asset Management Plan, and take appropriate action on engineer's recommendations.
8. Discuss Jackrabbit Road Public Utility District matters and take appropriate action.
9. Discuss District's participation in funding the flood wall proposed by Jackrabbit Road Public Utility District and take appropriate action.
10. Review Operations Report, authorize repairs, authorize preparation of Water Smart application and authorize termination of services to delinquent accounts.
11. Discuss possible impacts of Coronavirus (COVID-19) on the provision of services provided by the District and discuss the possible need for contingency planning.
12. Discuss and consider Rate Order and take any necessary action.
13. Discuss water fountain at Vanbury Playground and take appropriate action.
14. Report on WHCRWA monthly meeting, and related service and construction issues.
15. Discuss cyber security training.
16. Discuss trash and recycling operations.
17. Discuss District website.
18. Review Article for DVCA Newsletter.
19. Review agenda items for next meeting (April 9, 2020) and such other matters as may properly come before the Board.
